Post title:	JETS Workforce Senior faculty
Period of appointment:	Train the ENDO1 faculty, Train the ENDO3 faculty, 1 year (with intent to renew - reviewed each year)

JETS Workforce is designed for the whole endoscopy workforce; endoscopy nurses, healthcare assistants, operating department practitioners, decontamination technicians and other related roles. The programme completed a successful pilot in 2018 and launched in 2019. JETS Workforce provides a standardised framework for training and clear standards the workforce can work towards. This allows the service to clearly identify any gaps in knowledge, skills and experience in their workforce. For the staff, this provides them not only access to the standards but also access to training and further learning. We want to help the endoscopy workforce to feel valued, increase their job satisfaction and provide them with that sense of achievement through certification.

Responsibilities

The post holder will be part of the JETS Workforce faculty and be responsible for training either the ENDO1 or ENDO3 faculty. The post holder will report directly to JETS Workforce lead and maintain contact with JAG office personnel.

Key duties include:

- Attendance of annual senior faculty meetings
- Participation in calls and discussions prior to training sessions
- Training ENDO1/ ENDO3 faculty
- Delivering virtual competencies
- Delivering virtual introduction to JETS Workforce sessions
- Regular communication with the JETSW team
- Completion of active faculty requirements e.g: ENDO1 completing 2 courses per year and ENDO3 completing 1 course per year for the JETS Workforce programme.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for this role you must meet the following criteria

- You should be a registered clinical healthcare professional
- Experienced nurse or health care professionals with a track record of success
- You should be passionate about endoscopy and taking endoscopy to the next level
- Have knowledge of the JAG programme, JETS Workforce and their policies.
- Someone who is experienced at presenting and leading a group and who is eager to take part and improve the programme.

- Have support of their organisation to manage their time and commitment to working within the JETSW programme.

Location of duties

The ENDO1 course will be delivered virtually via Microsoft Office Teams. Each senior faculty member will be expected to deliver at least 2 virtual courses for the JETS Workforce programme. On site duties entail signing off ENDO3 faculty (London or Liverpool). The JETSW run 6 virtual ENDO1 courses per month and one face-to-face ENDO3 course per month. Additional training sessions take place virtually, twice per year.
